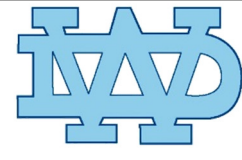




# SCHOOL DISTRICT OF WISCONSIN DELLS STRATEGIC PLAN

In an effort to improve student achievement levels, the SDWD has implemented the following strategies and actions that will in turn result in an increase in college and career readiness as measured by ACT achievement scores at WDHS:

- At the beginning of the 2014-15 school year, an *Academic Support Period (ASP)* was launched at WDHS. All students have a general resource time in their schedule that provides for intervention and support from core-area academic teachers if needed.
- During the spring of 2015, all 11<sup>th</sup> Grade students will take ACT Plus Writing and ACT WorkKeys as part of the Wisconsin State Assessment System---ACT Preparation Courses are offered at WDHS and are part of the general ASP.
- Curricular revisions are occurring to include the Common Core State Standards and the ACT College and Career Readiness Standards.
- Part of the SDWD *Professional Learning Community* initiative is centered on ACT success and achievement for *all* students.
- Instruction developed with consideration for “ACT Ideas for Progress” according to current student score ranges.
- Implementation of a uniform writing standards
- Daily use of Essential Question and Learning Objectives
